The Disabled Children and Young People's Register helps families to be kept up-to-date with information about services, entitlements, and events and activities for children and families, through regular newsletters and bulletins.

What is it?

The Disabled Children and Young People's Register helps families stay up-to-date with useful services, entitlements, events and activities for SEND children and families. It also offers the opportunity for families to be involved in discussions and consultations about future services and activities within Royal Greenwich.

Can my child be on the register?

Children and young people can be on the register if they:

- live in the Royal Borough of Greenwich
- are aged from birth to 19
- have a physical or learning disability, which is likely to have a substantial and longterm adverse effect on their ability to carry out usual day-to-day activities.
