Sport Premium Report

School Year 2020-21

What is Sports Premium?

Sport premium funding now stands at £16,000 per school with an additional £10 per pupil. This amounts to £18,640 for the full school year to August. The premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary-aged pupils. The overall aim is to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles. Spending is low this year due to Covid restrictions. For example, Breakfast Club coaches are usually funded from this budget. Below is a summary of how the funding is being used in Cherry Orchard this year.

Key Achievements to Date

Activity levels have been maintained, with each class devoting most of one afternoon session per week to PE. Children come into school in their PE kits on their designated PE day which saves significant time and disruption by not having to change.

Each class has its own box of PE equipment that is used at playtimes/lunchtimes and each class has been given a set of equipment to use for games in their PE lessons for each half term eg Year 4 did netball in A1 and are doing cricket in Y2. We are limited by not being able to use the hall but the weather has been reasonably kind (so far)!

The sports equipment in the playground has also been "Covid-Sprayed" and so now only needs to be wiped down with water. **Cost:£2,300***

Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety

Swimming: there is no swimming for school in Greenwich currently

Key Indicator 1- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity.

Equipment: Cherry Orchard continues to invest in new equipment to promote active and healthy lifestyles.

New crashmats and agility equipment sets for nursery.

Cost £1,772

Various PE equipment has been distributed among the year groups (balls, skipping ropes etc)

Cost £450*

Renewal of 5-a-day licence for use in class.

Cost: £268

Key Indicator 2 - raise the profile of PE and sport across the whole school

Whole School Events: none have been arranged this year due to Covid restrictions. This will be reviewed if regulations allow.

Bikeability training (level 1 & 2) is booked for Year 5 & 6 in the Spring Term (no charge).

Key Indicator 3 - increase confidence, knowledge and skills of staff in teaching PE and sport.

Greenwich Schools Sports Partnership: Cherry Orchard will renew its membership of the Greenwich Schools Sports Partnership this year. This is a borough-wide initiative aimed at creating an infrastructure to effectively deliver PE, School Sport and Physical Activity across Greenwich Primary Schools. As well as providing access to competitions

and events, this also includes staff professional development, delivery of healthy mind and body workshops and an inclusive swimming gala for Year 6. **Cost £950***

Key Indicator 4 - broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to children.

Sailing: We are also keen to offer children the opportunity to try new sports and activities. With this in mind, a group of 18 children from Year 6 will have the opportunity to attend a 2 day training session in June at the Ahoy Sailing Centre in Greenwich, achieving a RYA Sailing Stage 1 accreditation. **Cost £630***

Key Indicator 5 - increase participation in competitive sport

Opportunities severely limited so far this year. We have not yet heard when competitive sport will resume in the borough eg Meridian League

Remaining budget £10,471 (net of items of committed spend not included in last budget summary of 23/11)

Next Steps

Areas for further improvement

In order to facilitate more frequent & consistent use of the REAL PE programme, we have bought into the online offer which enables teaching staff to use their class IPAD in PE lessons, rather than relying on manuals and cards (which can be lost). This will also enable us to expand our PE offer to include REAL Gym and REAL Dance and will also offer children a login to use at home - useful in case of future lockdowns. A Staff Inset is being held in January 2021. **Cost £950***
